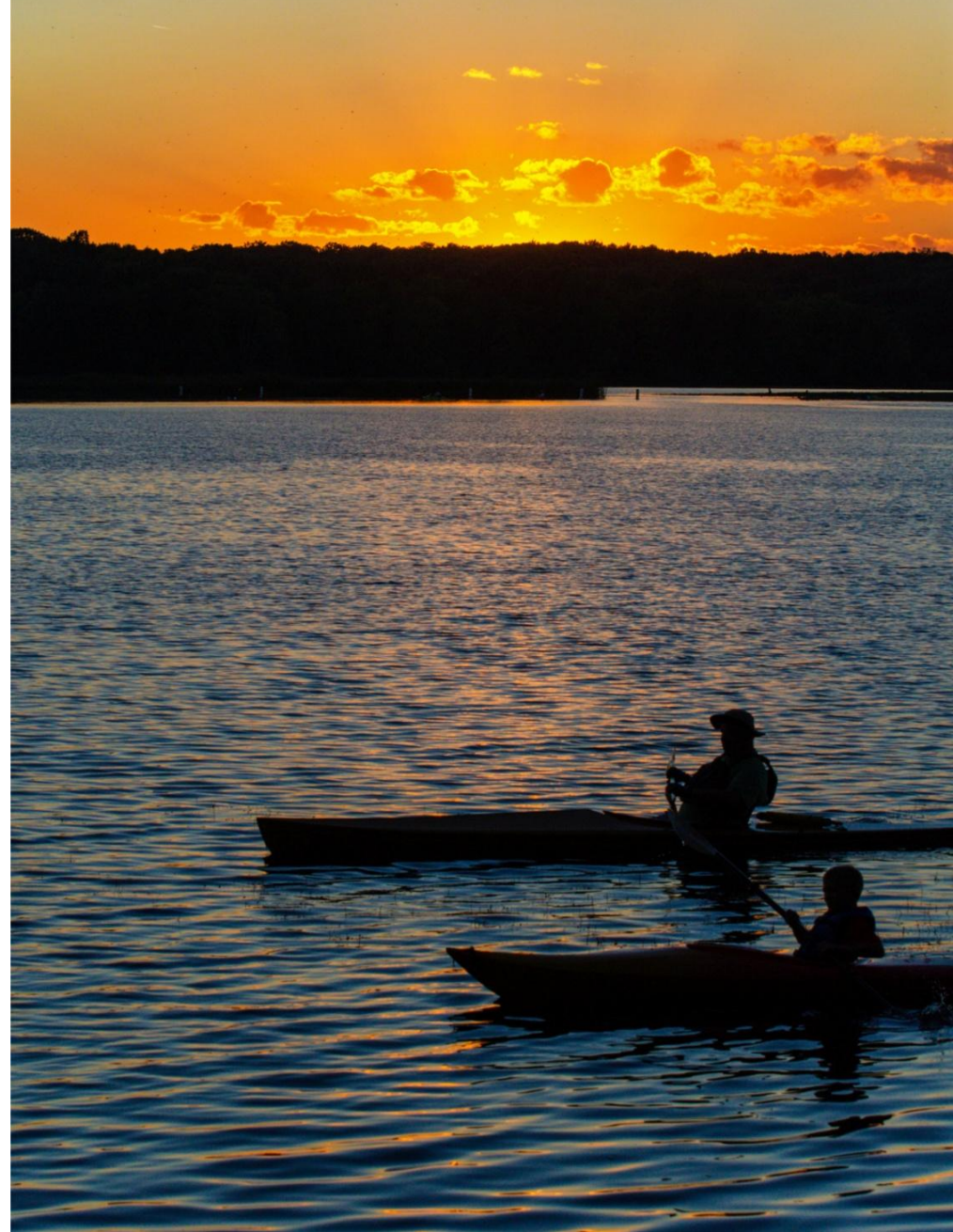


LARGE PRINT HYMNALS with a black cover are on the small bookcase in the rear of the sanctuary.
